

Pool Policies:

The pool is available to all members and their immediate families at no charge. Fee for in town guest is \$5.00 and out of town guest is \$1.00. Members must sign themselves and their guest in at the gate when arriving. There is a \$5.00 guest fee charge for in town guests (limited to six visits per season). Immediate family as defined by the Board of Directors: spouse, children, grandchildren, and parents whom reside in the member's home on a permanent basis. Family members whom are not considered immediate family will be charged \$5.00 per usage.

Private pool parties may be arranged through the Club Manager or General Manager. All teenage parties must be booked and chaperoned by one parent of the group. Guests may be included in private parties but are the responsibility of the host. There is a \$5.95 ++ minimum per person charge for pool parties, for all attendees. For parties in excess of 20 people, State Guidelines require us to add an additional Life Guard. The cost of the Life Guard is \$35.00 per hour with a minimum of 2 hours. Pool parties that are conducted prior to the opening or after the closing of normal operational hours will require one Life Guard for up to 20 people guaranteed. The charge per Life Guard is \$35.00 per hour with a minimum of 2 hours.

Private and group swim lessons are available by contacting the Pool Manager. In order to have a group lesson there must be six paid participants. Charges for swim lessons are as follows: Group lessons \$65.00 for six thirty minute lessons. Private lessons are \$30.00 per thirty minute sessions. You are responsible for ensuring your child's attendance. Fees will not be prorated for missed lessons.

Any person throwing or playing with rocks will be suspended from the use of the pool for one week for the first offense, two weeks for the second and suspended for the summer on the third offense.

Coolers or food and beverage are not allowed to be brought to the pool.
